Safety in student nurse medication administration is an area that has been explored by nurse researchers. While studies have revealed factors contributing to student medication errors and some addressed student concerns about patient safety.

The nurse was found negligent for administering medication she was unfamiliar with and for neglecting to clarify the order with the prescribing physician.³ Nurses are expected to be knowledgeable about the actions, side effects and contraindications of drugs.

When a nurse receives a medication order that is unclear, incomplete or inappropriate, the nurse must not perform the medication practice. Instead, the nurse must follow up with a prescriber in a timely manner. Competence Nurses ensure that they have the knowledge, skill and judgment needed to perform medication practices safely. Nurses ensure their medication practices are evidence-informed.
